BSEC fines Dominage Steel board Tk5.10cr over IPO fund diversion, fake proxy votes

The Bangladesh Securities and Exchange Commission (BSEC) has fined five directors and two former executive officers of listed company Dominage Steel Building Systems Limited a total of Tk5.10 crore for allegedly embezzling IPO proceeds, forging proxy votes and concealing material operational information.
